Who

This course is for **organizers**, **visionaries**, **and all students of history** who are willing to take up the study of people's struggle for liberation to strengthen and advance our movement today! Everyone is welcome to apply from all contexts, backgrounds, and identities. We encourage applications from those involved in, or seeking to become involved in, political organizations. **Participants can join the course in two ways:**

SELF-PACED TRACK

Participants have the flexibility to engage with the course dependent on their schedule, and can:

- A) attend live classes when they are able to OR
- **B)** view the recordings at a time that suits their schedule and/ or time zone. All participants will receive weekly emails that contain information regarding the week's classes, discussion forums, and reading materials. **To complete the self-paced track, participants can engage with the course at their own pace and submit reflections upon completion of each module.**

COLLECTIVE WORK TRACK

This track is for participants who would like to take on the full dimensions of the course and have additional time to engage in in-depth research. In addition to the above, **participants will be placed in a workgroup with other participants and meet weekly outside of class for collective discussion and to work on a collaborative project.** Groups will receive weekly prompts to guide their project work throughout the duration of the course for submission a week after the course ends.

*Please note, this is a more time-intensive track.

Our instructors include popular educators, movement leaders, intellectuals, and organizers all from the frontlines of struggle!

When

This is a 8-week course, running from March 14 to May 2, with an orientation on Tuesday, March 5.

Each week, classes will be mostly held on Tuesdays and Thursdays, from 6:30 - 8:30 PM ET, with some exceptions. Participants in the collective work track will designate a day and time to meet with their group outside of class time. If you live in a different time zone and can't attend live classes, the recordings will be shared right after each class.

Where

This is a hybrid course so that participants can join the course from anywhere in the world!

For those in the New York City area, please join us in person at **The People's Forum, 320 W 37th St., New York, NY 10018 (between 8th and 9th Avenues).**

To get to TPF, you can take the 1,2,3,7, A, C, E, M, N, Q, and R trains. TPF is an accessible building with elevators, wheelchair-accessible, gender-neutral bathrooms on both floors and masks at the front desk.



For participants who will be attending virtually, a Zoom link will be sent prior to each session.
